**1. Cebs -The Anglican Boys Society, Melbourne** is making available a limited number of financial grants to groups who provide a Christian ministry to children (particularly boys and young men of school age). Interested groups are invited to apply for one of these financial grants of an amount up to **\$500**. Financial grants will become available at start of **January 2020** and will be awarded based on the conditions and guidelines that follow.

#### **2. Conditions of award of financial grant**

2.1. If successful in obtaining a financial grant, the group shall acknowledge in their 2020 Annual General Meeting report that the grant has been provided by Cebs - The Anglican Boys Society, noting the designated project and amount.

2.2. If successful in obtaining a financial grant, the group shall within three months of the completion of the project send a written report to *Cebs – The Anglican boys Society detailing how the grant was used and the final outcomes of the project or if the grant was an annual (week by week) program a copy of their annual general report should additionally be provided.*

2.3. If, for whatever reason, an awarded Grant cannot be taken up by 31st July 2020, then the grant shall lapse. The applicant may re-apply in 2020 for the grant available in 2021.

2.4. Applications must be received by the Honorary Secretary on or before 30th September 2019.

### **3. Guidelines for award of financial grant**

3.1. Preference will be given to Anglican parish based programs, in particular providing ministry to boys and young men of school age.

3.2. Consideration will be given to non-Anglican Groups providing a Christian based ministry to boys and young men of school age.

3.3. Preference will be given to programs that are provide practical ministry applications rather than provision of a grant for administration support of a program.

3.4. Specialised training costs and provision of equipment for a group will be considered and in particular where the learned skills and or equipment can be shared with other groups that are providing similar ministry.

3.5. New and innovative programs are welcome.
